About the Artist

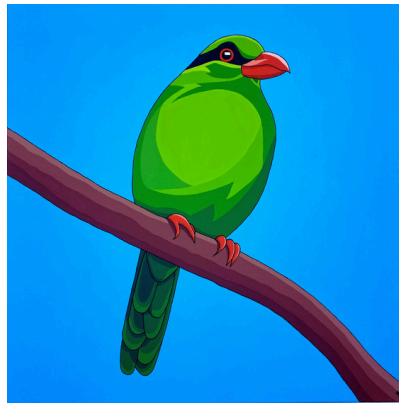

Pop Collection

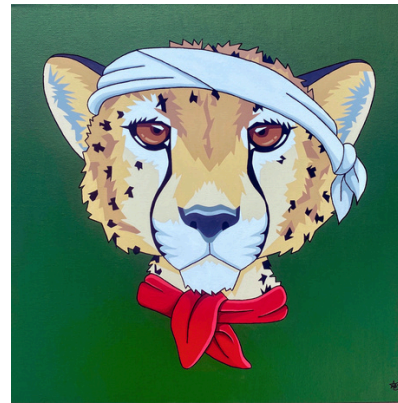

Oils Collection

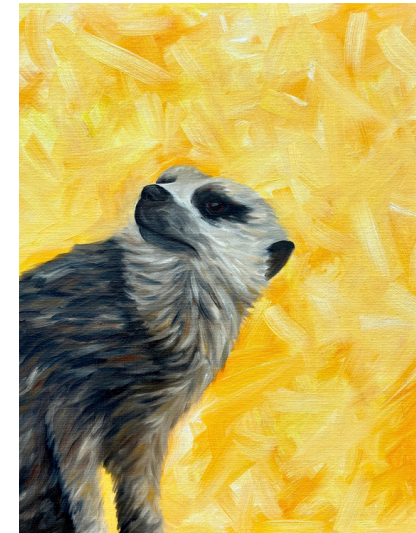

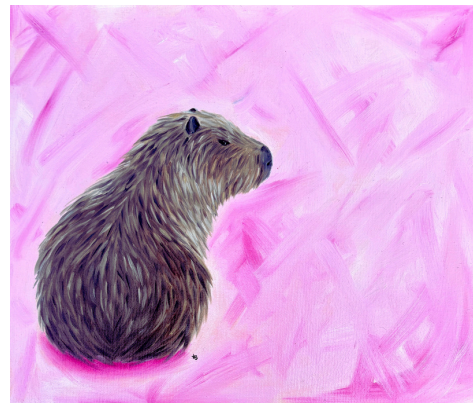
